CERVICAL CANCER

Cervical cancer is a cancer arising from the cervix. It is due to the abnormal growth of cells that have the ability to invade or spread to other parts of the body. Infection of the cervix with human papilloma virus (HPV) is the most common cause of cervical cancer.

Signs and Symptoms

- Vaginal bleeding after sexual intercourse
- Foul-smelling vaginal discharge
- Irregular bleeding between periods or after menopause
